

# NSW State Junior Championships

---

## 1. Introduction and Scope

All events shall be conducted in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls and with the Bowls NSW General Conditions of Play.

These Conditions of Play provide specific Conditions relative to NSW State Junior Championships.

## 2. Event Name

NSW State Junior Championships

## 3. Eligibility

### 3.1. Players

NSW State Junior Championships is an open gender event.

To enter and play in NSW State Junior Championships a player must be

- i. Registered as an Individual Member with Bowls NSW
- ii. Under the age of 18 years as at the scheduled completion date of the Championship.
- iii. Be registered as member of a Club with the relevant Zone, or with the relevant District with which that Club is affiliated.

### 3.2. Teams

Members of Teams are NOT required to be from the same Club. All members of teams must be members of Clubs within the Zone Boundaries.

## 4. Event Format

### 4.1. Qualifying

Qualification for State Finals shall be conducted within Zone Boundaries.

Zone Qualifying shall be conducted as a combination of sectional play and knockout as required.

Zone winners shall qualify for State Finals

### 4.2. State Finals

State Finals shall be conducted as a combination of sectional play and knockout.

## 5. Match Formats

The NSW State Junior Championships shall be played in three disciplines:

### 5.1. Singles

4 bowls per player.

Each match shall be played as 21 shots up. Shots in excess of 21 do not count

### 5.2. Pairs

4 bowls per player in the order lead 2 bowls, skip 2 bowls and repeat.

Each match shall be played over 15 ends

### 5.3. Fours

2 bowls per player.

Each match shall be played over 15 ends

## **6. Entry Fee**

The NSW State Junior Championships shall be played in three disciplines:

### **6.1. Zone Qualifying**

As determined by the respective Zone.

### **6.2. State Finals**

As determined by the Board of Bowls NSW
