Re: Rules for Clubs Reopening After Lockdown



With parts of NSW set to come out of lockdown from Monday 11th October 2021, clubs are preparing to reopen their venues. Bowls NSW Ltd would like to clarify some important rules that clubs must follow in accordance with the latest Public Health Order released on 3rd October 2021.

Maximum Number of People Allowed on Greens

From Monday 11th October, clubs must impose a limit of <u>20 people per green</u>. This applies to indoor and outdoor greens. There is no restriction on playing formats, as long as the total number of participants on a green does not exceed 20 people. Bowls NSW Ltd again reminds all clubs that District/Regional/Zone matches are not permitted to be played until further notice.

Please note that this restriction could be subject to further changes once NSW reaches the 80% double dose target.

Barefoot Bowls

Barefoot bowls is considered to be a form of social bowls. This means that clubs can allow barefoot bowls to take place on their greens once they reopen. In accordance with the current Public Health Order, any bookings for barefoot bowls must be restricted to a maximum of 20 people.

Double Vaccination Requirement

From Monday 11th October, all clubs operating in areas out of lockdown will be required to only allow fully vaccinated people onto the premises.
