

On Behalf of Bowls NSW, welcome to the 2022-23 Junior Inter-Zone 7-A-Side Championship.


This elite bowls event has a great history of not only being competitive but also of being played in a fashtastic spirit, showcasing the great aspects of our sport.

Conditions of Play

Duration of Matches

Singles: 21 shots up.

Pairs: 18 ends (3 bowls per player)

Fours: 15 ends

Trial Ends

1 trial end is permitted at the commencement of each match.

Determination of the Best Performed Side

Points shall be awarded based on the performance in each discipline. The Side scoring the greatest number of side points shall be declared the best performed side.

Determination of Section Winners

In each match of sectional play 3 points shall be awarded for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss.

- *The highest placed player/team in each section shall play off for Gold, Silver and Bronze medals.
- *2nd in each section shall play off for 5th to 8th place.
- *3rd & 4th in each section will play off for 9th to 14th place. Rankings for 9th-14th will be based on results over the 5 games played during the event.

Re-spotting the Jack

If a jack in motion passes completely outside the boundaries of the rink of play or rebounds to a distance of less than 18 meters

from the mat line, the end shall not be declared dead. Instead the jack shall be placed with the nearest point of the jack to the mat line at a spot which is 2 metre from the front ditch and on the centre line and play should continue.

If the spot mentioned above one is partly or completely covered by a bowl, the jack shall be placed with the nearest point of the jack to the mat line as close as possible to the covered spot at the opposite end of the rink without touching a bowl.

Restricting Movement of Players

After delivery of their first bowls, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head:

Singles: After delivery of their third bowl Pairs: Leads after delivery of their third bowl Skips after delivery of their second bowl.

Fours: Leads, seconds and thirds after delivery of their first bowl.

In exceptional and limited circumstances, a singles player may ask to visit the head or skip may ask that a player visit the head earlier than described in this Conditions of Play.

Variations to the Conditions of Play

The Controlling Body shall have the authority to vary the Conditions of Play to bring the Championships to a successful conclusion.


