At the Strategic Forum held earlier this year, Zone and District representatives highlighted boundary alignment as a major focus point that needed to be addressed. Bowls NSW has listened to the comments provided by our Zone and District representatives and formed a Boundary Working Party to begin this important process.

The subject of boundary alignment between Zones, Districts and Regions has existed for many years, and previous attempts to resolve the issues associated with it have been made by both the former Women's Bowls NSW and Royal New South Wales Bowling Association.
