Congratulations to each player on being selected to represent your state. To reach this stage is a wonderful achievement.


As well as facing some fierce competition, there is opportunity to form lifelong friendships, meet old mates and make some great memories.

## **Conditions of Play**

#### General

All matches shall be played in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls (Crystal Mark 4rd Edition, 2023) and the domestic regulations for Australia. Policies of Bowls Australia shall also apply.

The Controlling Body shall be the host State.

The Controlling Body reserves the right to alter the Conditions of Play if deemed necessary.

#### Sides

Each State participating will select sides from their affiliated members.

#### Substitutes

If a substitute is needed during the course of a match the substitute shall be chosen from the reserves of that side or if no reserves, the team officials from each state will have to agree on a suitable substitute.

#### **Inclement Weather**

Play will cease when the local temperature reaches 38oC and will be resumed at a later time in consultation with team, technical and club officials.

#### Smoking

Smoking is not permitted on the Green.

#### Game points

Game points will be allocated in sectional

play as follows:

- Three points for a win
- One point for a tie or no result

- Three points for a win by forfeit, and the average positive shot margin form the other matches in that section in the same round.

No points for a loss by forfeit, and the average negative shot margin from the other matches in that section in the same round.

#### Determination of overall winner

The side scoring the highest points shall be declared the winner.

If two or more sides are equal on points the side with the largest difference between total shots for and against shall be the winner.

If there is still a tie, the side with the lowest total shots against shall be the winner.

If there is still a tie, the side winning the highest number of ends over all games shall be declared the winner.

#### Format of Play

The format of Play for each event is as follows:

Singles: Four bowls per player, 21 shots up, (shots scored in excess of 21 shots shall not count)

Pairs: Three bowls per player, 18 ends. Triples: Two bowls per player, 18 ends Fours: Two bowls per player, 15 ends.

a time limit of two hours and fifteen minutes (not including trial ends) will apply to all matches for all events.

#### **Respotting the Jack**

If a jack in motion passes completely outside the boundaries of the rink of play, comes to rest in any hollow in the face of the bank, or rebounds to a distance of less than 18 metres from the mat line, the end should not be declared dead.

Instead, the jack should be placed with the nearest point of the jack to the mat line at a spot on the rink which is two metres from the front ditch and on the centre line, and play should continue.

If the spot mentioned in paragraph one is partly or completely covered by a bowl, the jack should be placed as close as possible to the covered spot, in line with that spot and the corresponding spot at the opposite end of the rink, without touching a bowl.

The spot(s) mentioned in paragraph one should be marked using chalk or some other suitable method.
