Bowls NSW Board Nominations Open

Following the initial term of the interim Board of Bowls NSW Ltd, nominations are now open for the election of eight (8) elected Directors to join the board.

Nominations must be delivered to the Chief Executive Officer before 10am Friday 6 October 2023.

Nominees should be fully aware of the roles and legal responsibilities of Directors as required by ASIC, which includes but is not limited to, obtaining a Director Identification Number (DIN) prior to any appointment.

Nominations

Per the Bowls NSW Constitution, nominations for the board must be:

- a. in writing;
- b. on the prescribed form, provided for that purpose;
- c. signed by an authorised representative from two (2) Clubs;
- d. certified by the nominee (who must be an Individual Member) expressing their willingness to accept the position for which they are nominated; and
- e. delivered to the Company not less than thirty-five (35) days before the date fixed for the AGM.



Regulations

Please refer to section 5.2 of the Bowls NSW Regulations for Elected Director eligibility criteria; Section 5.3 for Elected Directors Core Competencies and further eligibility information. It is important that

nominees are aware of the criteria and core competencies.










BowlsLink with Ben

Keno Brings The Wins To NSW Bowls Clubs In 2023



NSW bowling clubs and their customers have enjoyed a successful financial year alongside Keno in 2023, with millions of dollars in commissions paid, as well as cash and promotional prizes won.

The value of Keno to the NSW club industry remains stronger than ever, as the game continues to delight members and guests with winning moments and retail commissions bolster the robustness of clubs across the state.

Keno paid more than \$43.62 million in commissions to its NSW club partners in the 2023 Financial Year. an increase of 31% on commissions paid during the 2022 Financial Year.

Clubs weren't the only winners: players in NSW and the ACT enjoyed more than 55 million Keno wins

totalling more than \$739.59 million across the region, and more than \$345.5 million worth of cash prizes were won by club customers.

CLUBS' BIG WINNERS

During the year, Keno crowned 20 millionaires and multi-millionaires. who collectively took home more than \$46 million. Two of these major winners were from NSW bowling clubs: Ettalong Memorial Bowling Club - \$2.63 million and Telarah Bowling Club – \$1.14 million.

The biggest NSW club jackpot, worth \$3.8 million, was a 10-spot won at the Figtree Sports Club in Western Wollongong.

LOCAL AREA MARKETING

Keno's Local Area Marketing program reached new heights in 2023. Venues ordered more than 2,100 promotions – 47% more than in the 2022 Financial Year, and almost 400 venues who hadn't previously tried it ran a promotion for the first time.

The total value of prizes given way was just over \$1 million and promotions ordered ran for a total of 11,000 weeks, with an average of 5.27 weeks per promotion.
