### **Conditions of Play**

### **Open Sides & Senior Sides**

### General

All matches shall be played in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls (Crystal Mark 4th Edition April 2023) and the domestic regulations for Australia shall also apply.

The Controlling Body shall be the host State. The Controlling Body reserves the right to alter the Conditions of Play if deemed necessary.

### Sides

Each State participating will select sides from their affiliated members.

Male and Female competitions to be conducted as separate events.

Open and Senior competitions to be conducted as separate events.

### **Senior Side Player Eligibility**

Players shall be under 60 years of age at the opening day of the 2024 Bowls Australia Nationals.

### **Substitutes**

If a substitute is needed during the course of a match the substitute shall be chosen from the reserves of that side or if no reserves, the team officials from each state will have to agree on a substitute.

### **Inclement Weather**

Play will cease if the local temperature reaches 38oC and will be resumed at a later time in consultation with team and State officials.

In the Event of Inclement Weather 51 ends will constitute a match. Smoking

Smoking is not permitted on the bowling green, or the immediate surrounds.

### Sides

Each side shall comprise of three (3) teams each of four (4) players.

**Duration of Matches** 

Each team shall play 21 ends, 63 ends total.

### Scoring

In each Test, the side scoring the highest aggregate number of shots shall be declared the winner. If both sides score the same number of aggregate shots the Test shall be tied.

The side with the highest number of Test wins shall be declared the winner. If the number of Tests won is equal the trophy shall be retained by the State having last won the Series.

### **Trial Ends**

One trial end in each direction will be permitted prior to the commencement of each Test.

### **Dead Ends**

All dead ends are to be replayed.

### **Conditions of Play**

### **Under 25s/Development Sides**

### General

All matches shall be played in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls (Crystal Mark 4th Edition April 2023) and the domestic regulations for Australia shall also apply. The Controlling Body shall be the host State. The Controlling Body reserves the right to alter the Conditions of Play if deemed necessary.

#### Sides

Each State participating will select sides from their affiliated members.

Male and Female competitions to be conducted as separate events.

### **Player Eligibility**

Bowls NSW – players must be under 25 years of age on the final day of the Test series.

Bowls Victoria – there are no age restriction on selected players

### **Substitutes**

If a substitute is needed during the course of a match the substitute shall be chosen from the reserves of that side or if no reserves, the team officials from each state will have to agree on a substitute.

### **Inclement Weather**

Play will cease if the local temperature reaches 38oC and will be resumed at a later time in consultation with team and State officials.

In the Event of Inclement Weather

34 ends will constitute a match.

### Smoking

Smoking is not permitted on the bowling green, or the immediate surrounds.

### Sides

Each side shall comprise of a Pairs team, and a Fours team. Players can participate in a maximum of one Pairs match during the series.

### **Duration of Matches**

Pairs – 21 ends, 2 x 2 x 2 x 2 format

Fours - 21 ends, 2 bowls per player

### Scoring

In each Test, the side scoring the highest aggregate number of shots shall be declared the winner. If both sides score the same number of aggregate shots the Test shall be tied. The side with the highest number of Test wins shall be declared the winner. If the number of Tests won is equal the trophy shall be retained by the State having last won the Series.

### **Trial Ends**

One trial end in each direction will be permitted prior to the commencement of each Test.

### **Dead Ends**

All dead ends are to be replayed.

### **All Abilities Sides**

#### General

All matches shall be played in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls (Crystal Mark 4th Edition April 2023) and the domestic regulations for Australia shall also apply. The Controlling Body shall be the host State. The Controlling Body reserves the right to alter the Conditions of Play if deemed necessary.

#### Sides

Each State participating will select sides from their affiliated members.

Male and Female competitions to be conducted as separate events.

### **Player Eligibility**

All players must hold a IBD Parasport classification, that is registered with Bowls Australia.

Each side must contain a minimum of one B5/B6 player.

### **Substitutes**

If a substitute is needed during the course of a match the substitute shall be chosen from the reserves of that side or if no reserves, the team officials from each state will have to agree on a substitute.

### **Inclement Weather**

Play will cease if the local temperature reaches 38oC and will be resumed at a later time in consultation with team and State officials.

### In the Event of Inclement Weather

Triples & Pairs – 12 ends will constitute a match Singles – First to 17 shots to be declared the winner

### Smoking

Smoking is not permitted on the bowling green, or the immediate surrounds.

### Sides

Each Test will include a Triples match involving all three players. The second match in each Test will then comprise a Singles and Pairs match (3 matches per test).

Each member of the side will play one singles match. Test Match two will be a singles match for players with a B5/6 classification.

### **Duration of Matches**

Triples – 15 ends, 2 bowls per player
Pairs – 15 ends, 3 bowls per player
Singles – First to 21 shots, 4 bowls per player. Shots in excess of 21 do not count.

### Scoring

In each Test, the side winning the most matches shall be declared the winner. If both sides win an equal number of matches in a Test, the side scoring the highest aggregate number of shots shall be declared the winner.

The side with the highest number of Test wins shall be declared the winner.

### Trial Ends

One trial end in each direction will be permitted prior to the commencement of each Test.

### **Dead Ends**

All dead ends are to be replayed.
