

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Controlling Body

The State Match Committee is the Controlling Body.

Duration of Matches

Each match shall comprise of 63 ends (21 ends per rink). Dead ends shall be replayed.

Trial Ends

Two (2) trial ends shall be permitted at the commencement of each match.

Play Not Completed

If a match is not able to be completed (63 completed ends), a minimum of 54 completed ends shall constitute a completed match.

Point Scoring

In each match of sectional play points shall be awarded as follows:

Side Win: 7 points
Team Win: 1 point
Side Draw: 3.5 points
Team Draw: 0.5 points
Side Loss: 0 points
Team Loss: 0 points

Total Points per Match: 10 points

Determining Section Rankings

Sides shall be ranked within their section by the following criteria:

- **i.** The Side scoring the highest number of points.
- **ii.** The side with the largest difference between 'total shots for' and 'total shots against'.
- **iii.** The lowest 'total shots against' shall be the winner.
- **iv.** The aggregate results from matches played between the equal sides using (i.), (ii.), (iii.) above (in that order).

Sides:

Sides consist of three teams of four players. In all matches the draw will be Team 1 v Team 1, Team 2 v Team 2 and Team 3 v Team 3.

Any side changes must be nominated to Venue Controller.

Note: The team draw will be changed if Sides from the same section subsequently play against each other in post-sectional play.

Post Sectional Play

The highest placed side in each section will qualify for the Final. In Post Sectional Play, the side scoring the highest aggregate number of shots shall be the winner.

If scores are tied after 63 ends, each team shall play an extra end to determine the winner. If Side scores are tied after the extra end a further extra end (or ends) shall be played as necessary to determine a winner.

Variations to the Conditions of Play

The Controlling Body shall have the authority to vary the Conditions of Play to bring the event to a successful

conclusion.


