Basic Conditions of Play

Each Event is covered under the Bowls NSW General Conditions of Play, along with Conditions specific to the State Championships.

Singles All singles matches are 25 shots up. Shots in excess of 25 do not count.

Pairs Men's, Women's and Men's Senior Pairs are 4 bowls per player (2x2x2x2) 21 ends.

Open Reserve Pairs is 4 bowls per player (2x2x2x2) 18 ends.

Women's Senior Pairs is 3 bowls per player, 21 ends

Mixed Pairs is 3 bowls per player, 18 ends, time limit 2 hours 15 minutes*.

Triples Men's, Women's and Senior Men's are 2 bowls per player, 25 ends

Women's Senior & Open Reserve are 2 bowls per player, 21 ends

Fours Men's, Women's and Senior Men's are 21 ends

Women's Senior & Open Reserve are 18 ends

Mixed Pairs is the only discipline with time limits for matches, No time limits in any other disciplines.

Practice

Pre-event: Practice times for each discipline are allocated (refer to list on Page 3).

During event: If a player or team receives a forfeit, that player/team will be permitted to practice on the rink allocated for that match.

Otherwise, no practice permitted.

Please note that score cards will include advice of what side of the score board is to be used for each player/team —please ensure your scoreboard magnet is on the indicated side of the scoreboard, as this assists our staff and volunteers to quickly update live score updates (broadcast on live stream)

Lunches:

Host Clubs will have a pre-order lunch option for players who have a scheduled lunch break between games. Players are strongly encouraged to pre-order their lunch.

It is expected that food service at host clubs will be very busy. Resumption of play after lunch will not be delayed for players who do not pre-order lunch and experience delays in service.

If you have any special dietary requirements you should check with your host venue(s) on available options.

Please note that the match times shown on the Bowls NSW website and on BowlsLink are the start times for matches. "Call of Cards" time is 30 minutes before start time, for trial ends to commence 20 minutes before start time.

Check in:

Players should arrive at their venue a minimum of 30 minutes prior to their advertised start time to pre-order lunches (as required) and to collect score cards for team events.
