CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

1. Games will be played in line with the Laws of the sport of bowls (crystal mark edition) modified hereunder:
2. The Controlling Body is the Match Committee of Dunas Sports Club which reserves the right to make any alterations necessary to bring the tournament to a successful conclusion
3. Points on 2022 grading or last pennant grade—bowlers without a pennant grade 6 points
4. Composite teams will be accepted
5. The tournament will be 2 games of 21 ends—2 bowl triples
6. Open draw on arrival
7. One roll up will be allowed before each game (Optional)
8. There will be no dead ends—re spot the jack on the 2m mark (tee)
9. Winners will be determined by wins plus margins. In the event of equal winners the winner will be determined by number of ends won and/or count-back
10. No team can win more than one prize
11. 2nd Game Winners play winner, losers play losers drawn at lunch
12. In the event of a draw, teams play extra end to determine winner, margin not added to overall margin
