INFORMATION & PLAYING CONDITIONS

- * Open to all bowlers – men, ladies, and mixed teams.
- * Competition is two bowl fours.
- * Entry fee is \$1,600 per team, with full payment to be made by EFT only.
- * Breakfast & lunch (3 days), BBQ on Calcutta night, is included in the entry fee.
- * **Entry process:** All entries are to be made online through the tournament webpage with payment.
- * **Entries open on the Saturday, 1st April 2023 and close on Monday 7th August.**
- * **This is an application form only and does not guarantee entry into the event.**
- * **Successful entries will be advised by Tuesday 8th August.**
- * **42 Teams will be accepted.**
- * Open draw & Calcutta will be on Tuesday 12th September commencing at 6pm.
- * Competition on Wednesday and Thursday will be round robin with each team playing 3 games of 15 ends each day.
- * One end roll up per game.
- * **Dress code:** Bowls or Club uniform.
- * Jack will be replaced on the nominated mark in the case of a dead end.
- * Placings will be determined on the basis of most points and margins.
- * **3 points for a win 1 point for a draw 0 points for a loss**
(If required to separate ties ends won will determine placings)
- * Top 24 teams after round robin section will progress to the knockout finals on Friday.
- * Top 8 sides will contest the Cup final. Cup finals will be over 15 ends. No play offs for minor placings.
- * Placings 9 to 16 will contest the Shield final. Shield finals will be played over 10 ends. No play offs for minor placings.
- * Placings 17 to 24 will contest the Plate final. Plate finals will be over 10 ends. No play offs for minor placings.
- * Team ranked 1 after 6 round robin games will win \$4,000.
- * The City of Dubbo International Fours tournament committee reserves the right to alter the format of play to bring the tournament to a timely conclusion.
- * Competitors who withdraw an entry prior to the advertised close of entry date will be entitled to a refund of their entry fee. Competitors who withdraw an approved after the official close of entry date may not be entitled to receive a refund of their entry fee.
